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**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 103D.625 subd. 4 and Minn. Stat. § 103E.215, a Petition for an Improvement of Sibley/Renville/Mcleod Judicial Ditch 11, Lateral G (the “Petition”) has been filed by David Thomas Ludowese, et al. (collectively “Petitioners”) with the High Island Creek Watershed District (“HICWD”), acting as the drainage authority for Sibley/Renville/Mcleod Judicial Ditch 11 (“JD 11”). The Petition requests enlarging the existing drainage system’s tile to provide a 3/8” drainage coefficient.

WHEREAS, Shaun P. Luker, P.E., on behalf of Bolton & Menk, Inc., filed a preliminary engineer’s report with the HICWD Board of Managers;

NOW, THEREFORE, Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 103E.261, notice is hereby given that High Island Creek Watershed District, sitting as the Drainage Authority for JD 11 will hold a public hearing to consider the submitted improvement Petition, the preliminary engineer’s report filed by Bolton & Menk, Inc., and whether to dismiss the Petition or continue with the proceedings. The hearing will take place on **February 26, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. in the Basement Meeting Room, Sibley County Courthouse, 400 Court Avenue, P.O. Box 51, Gaylord, Minnesota 55334.**
